Campbell Folk School, The Swannanoa Gathering, The Jink & Diddle School of Scottish Fiddling, The North American Academy of Piping & Drumming, The School of Scottish Arts Dance Camp or The Thistle School of Scottish Country Dance. Other schools may be approved as long as they offer a focus in any Scottish art. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee will be guided by the applicant's needs, objectives, commitment, anticipated development and goals.

Recommendation by a current teacher, advisor or sponsor is required. No application will be considered without such a recommendation.
